The Brake Transmission Shift Interlock (BTSI) locking pin may become stuck in the open position. A BTSI locking pin stuck in the open position may allow the transmission to be shifted out of PARK and to or from any gear position without depression of the brake pedal and/or without the key in the ignition, if a key is applicable. This increases the potential for an unintended vehicle rollaway that may result in a vehicle crash or injury without prior warning.

Some vehicles may have been built with an outboard steering linkage jam nut that could loosen allowing one end of the drag link to separate from the adjuster sleeve. A drag link separation can result in a loss of directional steering control, which can cause a vehicle crash without prior warning.
